



VOLLEYBALL

1. FACILITIES

1.1. Technical installations

- A minimum number of 2 full size pitches with all the regulation line markings.
- For warming up it is recommended to provide 3 pitches.
- Official nets with antenna.
- The courts must be distinctively separate and if possible with a dividing curtain.

1.2. Ancillary facilities

- Dressing rooms with toilets and showers
- dressing room for the referees
- room for tournament organizers (and eventually injured player).

2. TECHNICAL EQUIPMENT

2.1. Specific materials

In every court there must be:

- table and chairs for the scorer and an assistant
- 2 benches for both teams
- refereeing chair
- 2 penalty chair
- whistles and score sheets (paper or electronic)
- measuring rod
- electronic or manual scoreboard
- 12 warm up balls of the same supplier as per game ball (6 balls for each team)+ manometer.

2.2. Miscellaneous equipment

- Brush and mop to wipe the floor
- pole protections.

2.3. Administrative materials

- Fixtures for matches and results should be shown on gym notice board

- a minimum of Two colored pens (red and black)for Scoresheets.

3. STAFF

3.1. Local responsible + deputy

3.2. Table staff :

- scorekeeper
- responsible for scoring sheet
- a referee responsible (in case of young referees). Each match we need 2 official referees. In case of young referees they will be integrated in agreement with the OTI.

3.3. Auxiliary staff :

- one manager per field
- a cloakroom responsible
- a person in charge of the service or order
- a responsible of facilities and equipment
- a head of the medical service.

4. Progress of the competition
