SPECIFICS – TABLE TENNIS

1. FACILITIES

1.1. Technical installations

- 8 tables minimum,
- each play zone is separated.

1.2. Ancillary facilities

- at least 2 dressing rooms, with a clear demarcation for girls and boys, with toilettes and showers,
- a dressing room for the referees,
- a room for the secretariat,
- medical service + ambulance at the venue.

2. TECHNICAL EQUIPMENT

2.1. Specific equipment

- official competition balls approved by FITT,
- template to measure racket thickness.

2.2. Miscellaneous equipment

- markers at each table,
- table chair for the referee and scoreboard,
- table and chair for the judge-referee and the assistant,
- sound system.

2.3. Administrative material

- office supplies,
- scoreboard for the order of the matches, the timing and results.

3. STAFF

3.1. The responsible for the COJFI and his assistant

- The responsible for the competition is the judge-referee.

3.2. Referee team

- one referee per match.

3.3. Ancillary service

- a responsible for the facilities and the equipment,
- a head of the medical service.

4. PROGRESS OF THE COMPETITION
