SPECIFICS – VOLLEYBALL

1. FACILITIES

1.1. Technical installations

- in case of a maximum 6-team tournament, a minimum number of 2 full size pitches (1 for girls and 1 for boys) with all the regulation line markings,
- in case of a 7 to 9 teams in the tournament, 1 extra pitch is needed,
- In case of a 10 to 12 teams tournament, 2 extra pitches are needed,
- for warming up it is recommended to provide another pitch,
- official nets with antenna,
- the courts must be distinctively separate and if possible with a dividing curtain.

1.2. Ancillary facilities

- dressing rooms with toilets and showers,
- dressing room for the referees,
- room for tournament organisers (and eventually injured player).

2. TECHNICAL EQUIPMENT

2.1. Specific materials

In every court there must be:

- table and chairs for the scorer and an assistant,
- 2 benches for both teams,
- refereeing chair,
- 2 penalty chairs,
- whistles and score sheets (paper or electronic),
- 1 measuring rod,
- electronic or manual scoreboard,
- 3 official FIVB approved game balls,
- 12 warm-up balls (6 per team) of the same brand and type as the game balls,
- manometer.

2.2. Miscellaneous equipment

- brush and mop to wipe the floor,
- pole protections.

2.3. Administrative materials

- fixtures for matches and results should be shown on gym notice board,
- a minimum of 2 pens for the scoresheets.

3. STAFF

3.1. Local responsible + deputy

3.2. Table staff

- scorekeeper,
- responsible for the scoring sheet,
- a referee responsible (in case of young referees). Each match we need 2 official referees. In case of young referees they will be integrated in agreement with the OTI.

3.3. Auxiliary staff :

- one manager per court,
- a cloakroom responsible,
- a person in charge of the service or order,
- a responsible of facilities and equipment,
- a head of the medical service.

4. PROGRESS OF THE COMPETITION

4.1. Time blocks for the volleyball tournament

Time blocks of 2h30 are needed per match, so maximum 3 matches per day on a pitch.

4.2. Match regulations

According to the general regulations of the FISEC of the collective sports, the specific regulations of FISEC volleyball are governed by the regulations of the FIBV.
