



## Code of conduct FISEC/FICEP Games (for national delegates, coaches, trainers)

### Introduction

Participation in the FISEC/FICEP Games as a coach or trainer means that you take on the responsibility for your participants' sporting achievements but also for keeping them safe outside the competitions. To make sure that all delegations are supervised so that they are safe and behave according to the rules in the code of conduct and house rules for participants, a code of conduct has been drawn up for those accompanying the participants.

### Before the Games

The national delegate is responsible for ensuring that the code of conduct for participants is discussed and signed before departure to the Games. The national delegate sends a digital copy of the signed codes of conduct to the secretary of CIRPP of hands in them in during the accreditation.

### During the Games

#### Code of conduct

Those accompanying the participants ( e.g national delegate, coach, trainer):

- ensure fair play and honesty at all times
- are expected to actively advocate sports that are clean and free of manipulation in accordance with the WADA World Ant-Doping Code.
- are respectful towards other participants, local organisers, the Bureau and all others involved in the Games during the entire Games.

Any abuse to hurt, insult, intimidate or provoke others, will be considered a serious fact and will be punished severely and may also have consequences for participation in the sports competitions.

#### House rules

Those accompanying the participants ( e.g national delegate, coach, trainer):

- are present at the meeting with the OTI per sport at the beginning of the Games, Games, ensuring that one adult remains with the participants for supervision.
- ensure that at least one coach is always with the delegation at any time.
- do not give participants permission to leave the group .
- ensure that there is no noise in the accommodation from 23.00 to 6.30 or that anybody leaves their room during that period.
- ensure that rooms are only used by their occupants.
- are not allowed to smoke or vape in the presence of participants.
- cannot give participants permission to buy or use alcohol, drugs or other forbidden substances .
- check the rooms of their delegation at the beginning and the end of the Games to ensure that there is no damage. If so, report to the secretariat of the games.
- ensure that their participants know the escape routes from the accommodation.
- are responsible for the behaviour of their delegation at all times.
